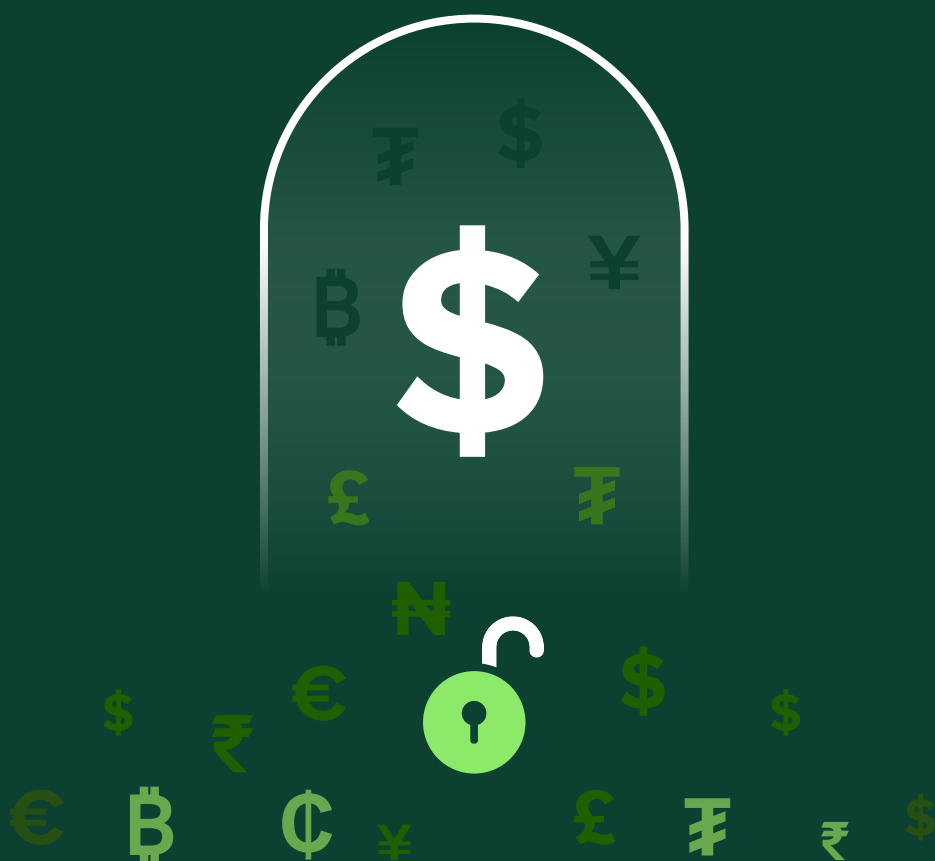

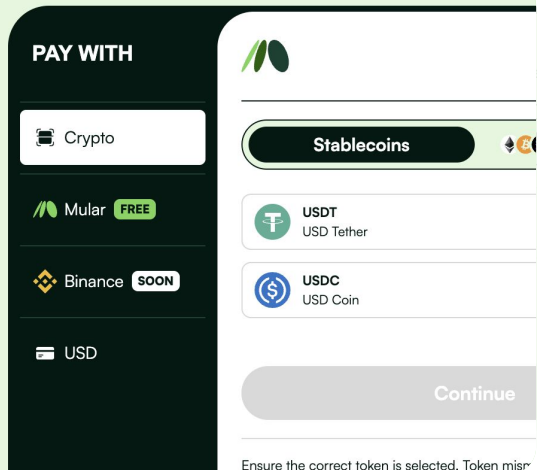

Integration Options

Withdrawal Fee (₦100)



Customer to bear withdrawal fee

The withdrawal fee would be added to whatever the customer's bill is.



Business to bear withdrawal fee

The withdrawal fee would be deducted from the amount paid by the customer

Settlement Currency



NGN (Settled instantly)

The Naira value is instantly sent to the business's NGN account



USD (Withdrawable as NGN)

The USD equivalent is stored on a Business account on Mular and can be withdrawn later
